

REGISTER OF MEMBERS' INTERESTS Parish Council Code of Conduct adopted July 2022

The Localism Act 2011 The Relevant Authorities (Disclosable Pecuniary Interests) Regulations 2012

Members' attention is drawn to the following notes:

- The Council's Code of Conduct provides for registration and disclosure of pecuniary interests and interests other than pecuniary interests. This form gives general guidance on those interests that need to be disclosed if you need advice or assistance please speak to the Council's Monitoring Officer. Continuation sheets should be used where needed and clearly marked.
- Where you consider that information relating to any of your interests is a 'Sensitive
 Interest', please could you seek the assistance of the Council's Monitoring Officer before
 you complete and return this Form.
- A 'Sensitive Interest' is an interest which could create or is likely to create a serious risk
 that you or a person connected with you may be subjected to violence or intimidation.
- Where the interest is no longer a 'Sensitive Interest' you must notify the Monitoring Officer within 28 days of that change.
- 5. Reference to Member is taken to include an elected or co-opted member to the Council.
- 6. The Council's Monitoring Officer is required to ensure that a copy of the Council's Register of Members Interests is both available for inspection and also that the Register is published on its website.
