### AGENDA

1. To receive, and consider for acceptance, apologies for absence from Members of the Council.
2. To receive any declarations of disclosable pecuniary interests or non-registerable interests by members or the Clerk and to consider any requests for dispensation.
3. To receive:
  - a. Questions or comments from members of the public regarding items on the agenda.
  - b. Representations from any member who has declared a personal interest.
4. To approve the minutes of the planning meeting held on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2021.
5. To discuss any matters arising from the minutes of the above planning meeting.
6. To consider the co-option of a councillor to fill the vacant seat. Two candidates have submitted an application form; Nicholas Watkins and Ima von Wenden. Each candidate will be invited to speak for up to two minutes. Both candidates will leave the room for the voting.
7. To receive a report from the Flood Warden, Nick Watkins, an update on the Pond Project plans and timescales and to consider the dig out of a ditch at the allotments.
8. To review the External Audit Report from PKF Littlejohn and agree actions to be taken if any.
9. To agree and ratify the annual payments for the village Courtesy Lights.
10. Grounds Maintenance / Environmental Projects:
  - a. To consider the purchase of a ride on mower that can be used to maintain footpaths.
  - b. To consider the purchase of mulch / feed for the trees in the community orchard.
  - c. To consider planting the free wildflower seeds from BBO Wildlife Trust in the village
  - d. To consider a location to plant 3 Prunus Tai Haku (white flowering ornamental cherry blossom trees) gifted by WBC Countryside during Tree Planting Week (end of November)
  - e. To consider involvement in the 'Queen's Green Canopy: Plant a Tree for the Jubilee'
  - f. To consider the request to fell trees along 11A Churchside, the footpath along the recreation ground and the land in between 11A Churchside and the Playground.
11. To review the Parish Council Public Liability Insurance proposal from Came and Company.
12. To discuss the return of the Speed Indicator Devices and the set up of booking the systems for trained users.
13. To receive the Clerk's report including update on finances and correspondence received.
14. To receive further questions or comments from members of the public.
