The Clerk enquired if any Councillor wished to attend the meetings for the Downland Practice Group. Councillor Culver requested further details of meetings.

Councillor Culver raised the issue of litter picking in the village and it was agreed this should still go ahead although all the equipment from West Berks is not available until May. A date is to be agreed.

A member of the public raised a query regarding the Silent Soldiers which were donated by the Residents and Parish Council for the centenary celebrations in 2018. The British Legion Parade is to be held at Aldworth in 2019 and the Legion enquired if the silhouettes could be used in Aldworth. The consensus from the Parish Council was that as the silhouettes had been provided by the residents, by local businesses and also by the Parish Council, these silhouettes should remain within East Ilsley. It was suggested that the silhouettes be erected at the village pond and at the Church in November and Alan Harris would be approached for his assistance with this.
