040/22 Planning application ref: 22/01323/HOUSE for a first floor extension with minor alterations

to the ground floor at The Old Pool House were reviewed and discussed. We were joined by the homeowner who was able to explain the plans and answer any questions. Upon voting, all Councillors were in favour of **approving** the application and recommended to the Clerk to inform West Berkshire Planning Department that we have **no objections**. The

Clerk will submit the Parish Observation Sheet to the Planning Department.

O41/22 Three Section 137 Grant Requests had been received and these were discussed one by

one:

1) St Mary's Church PPC - £400.00 - Annual Grant for Grass Cutting - Approved.

2) Local History Society - £300.00 - Website Hosting - Approved.

3) GreenFest 2022 - £200.00 - Festival Support - Approved.

It was also **agreed** that the Parish Council would assist in some additional way with the GreenFest 2022 Day. Ideas include hiring an electric mini bus to ferry people from East Ilsley to Hampstead Norreys and back, pay for adult and children bus fares to Hampstead Norreys and back, and to plan out a safe walking / cycling route with key facts and information along the way that align with the key messages the festival will highlight. The Clerk will work on these options in the next couple of months.

There were no further questions or comments from members of the public. Cllr. Sharp advised that the funeral had been arranged for Mrs Mo Moulton and would be taking place on Thursday 7th July. The cremation service is at 1pm at West Berkshire Crematorium, with the wake taking place from 3pm at The Crown and Horns. The tree that has fallen down on the green along the High Street between Corace House and Steadman House is being dealt with by Martyn Driscoll and we will look to replace the trees when planting season returns.

With there being no further business, Cllr. Pembroke thanked all for attending and the meeting closed at 19.25pm.
