### Minutes of the Virtual Parish Council Planning Recommendation Meeting

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- 030/22 Cllr. Pembroke welcomed all to the meeting. Apologies were received from Cllr. Meadows due to work commitments which were **accepted**. Quorum was **achieved**.
- 031/22 There were no declarations of interest received, nor any requests for dispensation.
- 032/22 There were no questions from any members of public present, nor any representations given.
- 033/22 Planning application ref: 22/01148/FUL for St Mary's Church was reviewed and we were joined by Mr Christian Randall, the architect for the project. Christian explained the purpose of the modifications at the Church and how the space needs to be used by the whole community, not just the congregation. Making the Church accessible to everyone was the main priority and this application allows for a wheelchair friendly ramp to be installed and to remove some height discrepancies around the main entrance. A short conversation was had around the existing steps and how they will be built into the design and the proposed lighting was queried as to whether these would be on a timer so they are not illuminated during the night-time. All were in favour to **support** this application and a comment on the LED lighting would be added to the Parish Observation Sheet. The Council recommended the Clerk to action this after the meeting.
- 034/22 Planning application ref: 22/01008/HOUSE for 17 Churchside for a Single storey rear extension was reviewed and discussed. The previous application was viewed and there were no questions regarding the amended plans. All were in favour to **support** this application with no comments. The Council recommended the Clerk to action this after the meeting.
