**The A34 Trunk Road (East Ilsley – Northbound Exit Slip
Prohibition) Order 2020**

Highways England Company Limited(a), in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1(1)(a) and 2(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(b), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A34 Trunk Road (East Ilsley – Northbound Exit Slip Prohibition) Order 2020.

2. In this Order –

“the A34” means the A34 Trunk Road in the County of Berkshire;

“longitudinal marking” means road marking of a type shown in diagram 1004 in Part 4 of Schedule 11 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(c);

“the off-slip road” means the road leading from the northbound carriageway of the A34 to Fidler’s Lane at East Ilsley Junction; and

“the relevant road” means that length of the off-slip road beginning at the diverge from the northbound carriageway of the A34 and ending at the point where the road is separated from another part of the carriageway by longitudinal marking.

3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed (or to enter so as to proceed) in a south-easterly direction on the relevant road.
